So we're gonna look at some keynote tips and tricks now. Start off some basic shapes and go in and click the plus and go to the shapes menu. And you can bring in a square, grab the handle, and you can move it and change the size of it all you want. It's really it's really cool. You can do the same thing with the circle. Now circle has is a little bit unique. It will also let you make it oblong and make it change the parents of it. Now you can do some really cool and unique things as well by combining some shapes. So we're going to bring in multiple shapes, in this case, and I've got a green circle here. And we're going to bring in the star we're going to copy and paste it several times.

And we want to place the stars around the circle on top of it but overall Now you have to be careful. The search star is one of those unique shapes that you can change the shape of it and make it unique. Don't forget, you can always undo things.

Now, if we got it in there, we're going to go and tap and select everything on the screen all five of these shapes. And then we're going to use the format tool that will paintbrush and we're going to go in and combine these shapes and get rid of all the blue and leaving just the green circle without the blue parts. Now bring in another circle. And we're gonna go in and make it the same size as the original green circle. And you can use your format tool and go to arrange and move that blue circle behind the green one. No, now we've got a beach ball. And then if you go in and select everything, you can actually group it together and you can move all of it together like it's in a shape that would come. You can also break shapes apart not all the shapes, but some shapes you can break apart and do some cool stuff you can break piece of adware like you have to crayon get rid of the tip of it because it's worn down or whatever you want to do. So you tap on it go to a range, and then you can break it apart and change things I can I want to change the color and make the label different because it's not the same shade as the crayon itself. And then you can tap and select everything and group them back together and move it around just like it was the original piece. You can also do some other cool things and you can manipulate them. So we got this graph going upwards, we can break it apart. Now not only can I change the color of the line, if I wanted to I can also flip it and make it go down and then combine everything back together and it's a single shape. Again, you can combine shapes as well, we're gonna look at real quick of what some of the different options do with two circles. So I'm gonna put them and overlap them. And we're going to change one I'm gonna make it red. So you can see the difference between the two pieces, and the red ones on top. And that's important because that's what happens if you combine them the bottom color comes up. You can also combine it this way and just combine what's the same you can get mask, the bottom one with the top, you can also get rid of

what's the same. Then we can mask the image as well. So we can do some of the same stuff. Go and select everything. And then in that pop up menu, you can hit mask with shape. We can get rid of all the rest of the photo and we've masked it to work. A shape we want it to, you can draw and animate as well. So if you tap with pencil on the screen, it'll bring up the animation tool, the drawing tools. We've got a marker, pencil crayon, fill tool, eraser, and the Select tool and then your color selector. So I can go ahead and draw in here. And then with my marker, I'm going to show you a little bit more of the things you can do is you can change the opacity. Now, that makes it so that things will show up through it. Or if you want to, you just change the tint a little bit. Now, I can also do some cool stuff, I can animate this drawing, so I'll tap on it, select animate, built in, and then do line draw. And I'll actually animate what I just drawn so you can show that process of how your 3d work. You can select and move drawings as well.

Now, this isn't just move all of it. So as I'm going in, oops, I put this in the wrong place, but no point erasing it. I'm just going to grab my lasso tool, circle the word Phoenix, and then just move it. And it's all back together again. I can also draw with a filter. So I can not not only can I fill in a solid, something that has a line drawn all the way around it, but I can just use it to draw on its own.

Now, if I don't like the color of my walls, I can actually go in and just change those. So say I don't want a red house, I want it to be blue. Select your fill tool, change, select the color you want greens, not really, I don't want to go blue. And I just tap on the color and it'll change the color of that. One make the roof gray instead of black is a little too hot. There we go. So be creative. Have fun.
